

CLEP Examination Schedule

CLEP: College Level Examination Placement. It is produced by the College Board, which also offers the Advanced Placement (AP) exams and the SAT exams.

The numbers in the parentheses refer to college semester credits. A total of 60 are required for the AA degree: lower division.

CLEP exams are offered all year round. AP exams are offered only once a year, which limits most students' options. It reduces the number of credits that students can earn in high school. The correct goal should be to quiz out of lower division and enter college as a junior.
